



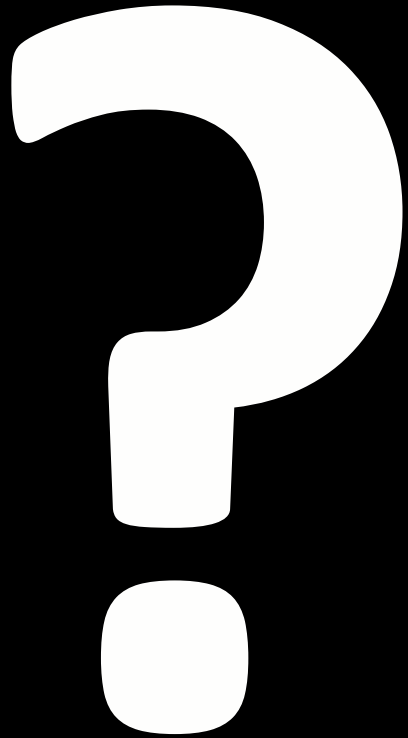

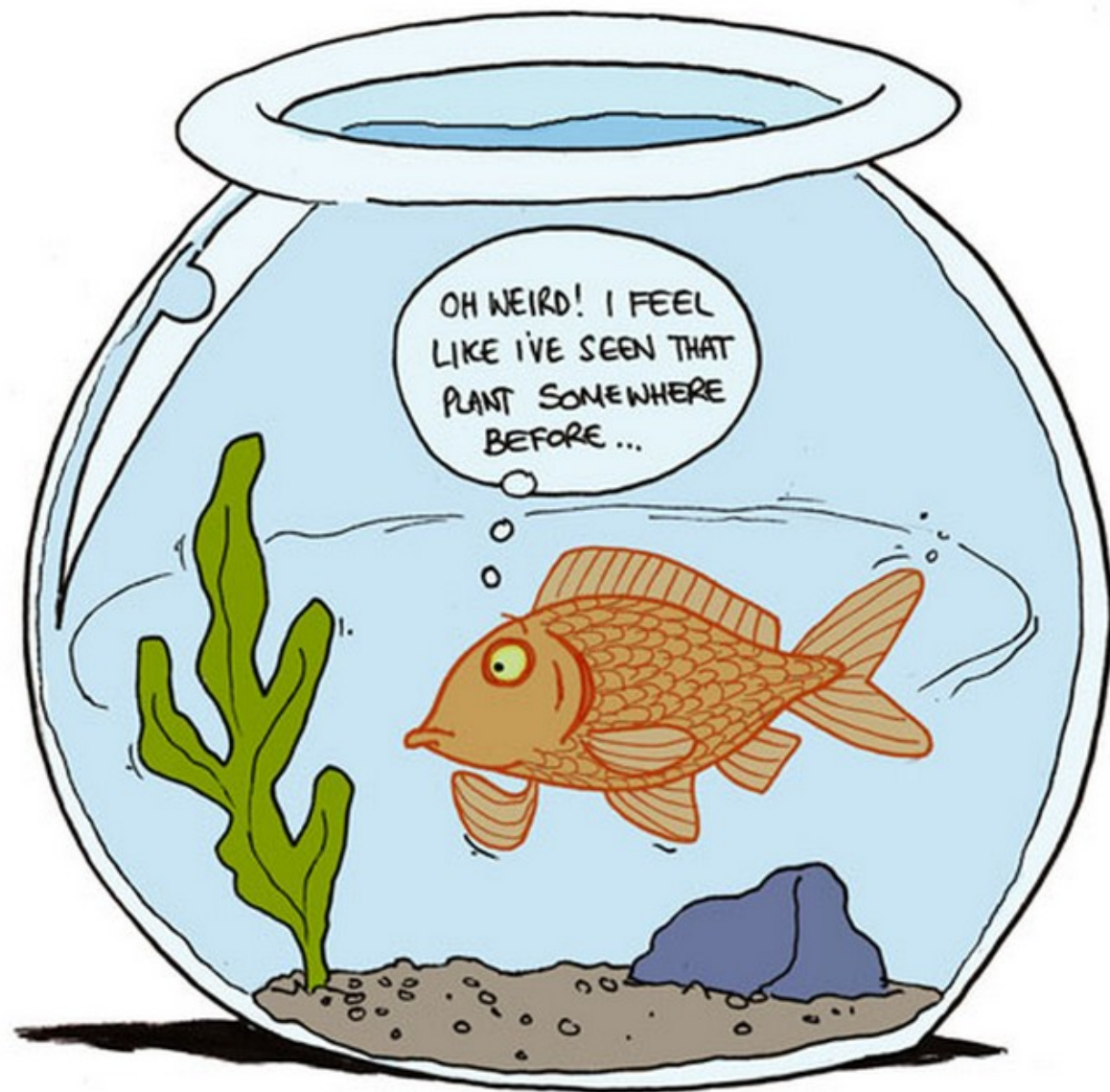

“Then take care of my sheep,” Jesus said.


A third time he asked him, “Simon son of John, do you love me?”
